Wednesday, July 19, 1989: Field trip participants assemble at Casper, Wyoming, airport by 8:00 P.M. (United Airlines flight leaves Dulles International Airport 2:15 P.M. and arrives Casper airport 7:50 P.M.) Group transported by field trip vehicles to Holiday Inn at Douglas, Wyoming (305-358 9790).

Thursday, July 20, 1989 (Snyder): Vehicle caravan proceeds through geology stops in Archean metasedimentary rocks with unusually well-preserved primary structures in Hartville uplift to Bunkhouse Motel, Guernsey, Wyoming (307-836 2356). Cultural opportunity to visit traces of Oregon Trail stage coach route by which migrating settlers populated western U.S. in late 19th century.
